ROLE DESCRIPTIONS & GUIDELINES

SCORE BOARD ATTENDANT

Reports to: Team Manager and/or Roster Coordinator

Purpose of the role

The Scoreboard Attendants role is to provide an accurate score for players and supporters attending home games. (Away games are done by the home team).

Qualifications & Desirable Characteristics

- Concentration
- Ability to do basic math eg 6 times tables and additions.

Duties & Responsibilities

- Be at the scoreboard 5 minutes before the game start time.
- The U14 Shift will need to put in place the name of the opposition team.
- Concentrate on the game and watch for when the goal umpire signals a point or goal.
 - GOAL: Two flags
 - POINT: One flag
- Scoreboard numbers are stored in the scoreboard shed. Using these numbers provided, add to the score after each goal or point and ensure the total score is also changed and correct.
- If you are unsure your score is correct, you can check with the closest goal umpire at the $\frac{1}{4}$ or $\frac{1}{2}$ time breaks or when the ball is not near the goals.
- Each goal is worth 6 points. Each point is worth 1 point. Eg 2 goals and 5 points will equal 17.
- At the completion of the game, wait a few minutes and then return all the numbers neatly in number order to the shed ready for the next game.
- Members doing this role can be reimbursed by the BSFC Treasurer.

NOTES:

- U9's who are rostered to undertake scoreboard duties will need parent supervision if they deem necessary.
- Scoreboard duties are shared amongst junior players.

Time Commitment: 1-2 hours per duty or as requested
